Description	<i>Côte du Rhône AOC already has the reputation to offer some of the best value wines in France and even some premium reds but, this is especially true with Domaine Les Hautes Cances. Located around the village of Cairanne, not far from Châteauneuf-du-Pape, this small family estate, was recently acquired by Domaine Pierre Amadieu. Former owners, Anne-Marie and Jean-Marie Astart, hand crafted this exceptional wines from old vines and low yields (in some cases as low as 18 hectolitres per hectare, half the average yield in the Rhône) so it would be an understatement to say they are passionate about what they do. Sourced from 50 years old vines on average, aged for 12 months in old Burgundian barrels and made with Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre and Carignan. Is this Châteauneuf du Pape in disguise? A traditional wine with lots of cherry fruits alongside savoury, spicy, and earthy notes. Full-bodied with soft round tannins. Perfect with grilled meat!</i>

Description	<i>This long established family Bodega lies in the best part of Rioja, on the limestone ridges of the Alavesa region. They only use fruit from their own vineyards and have rigorous standards in the cellars in order to create wines with elegance and pungency combined with the soft spicy allure that only well made Tempranillo can offer. Valserrano is gaining a reputation amongst Rioja's best, receiving high score from renowned wine critics. Made with 95% Tempranillo and 5% Mazuelo, this Crianza was aged for 16 months in American and French oak. Aromas of ripe black fruit and hints of oak and cinnamon. Medium to full-bodied with juicy fruits, soft tannins and good length. Received 91 Pts from both Robert Parker's Wine Advocate & Tim Atkin</i>

Description	<i>The Bousquet family combines four generations of traditional winemaking with Mendoza's ideal winegrowing conditions. Their constant search to achieve optimum ripeness allows them to create wines that boast delicious fruit character with ripe tannins and high acidity and are constantly receiving great reviews from wine critics. Fermented in contact with American oak and aged for 6 months. A typical Malbec with aromas of blackberry and cassis and hints of spice and black pepper. Medium bodied with silky tannins and ripe fruit flavours. Overall, smooth and elegant.</i>
